

# About Khabarovsk

In 1858, the land known as Khabarovka (now Khabarovsk) was transferred to Russia under the Treaty of Aigun. The Russians founded the military outpost of Khabarovka, named after a Russian explorer [Yerofey Khabarov](#). The post later became an important industrial centre for the region. Town status was granted in 1880.

In 1894, a department of Russian Geographical Society was formed in Khabarovsk and began initiating the foundation of libraries, theaters, and

museums in the city. Since then, Khabarovsk's cultural life has flourished. Much of the local indigenous history has been well-preserved in the **Regional Lore Museum** and Natural History Museum and in places like near the Nanai settlement of Sikhachi-Alyan, where cliff drawings from more than 1,300 years ago can be found. The Khabarovsk Art Museum exhibits a rare collection of old Russian icons.

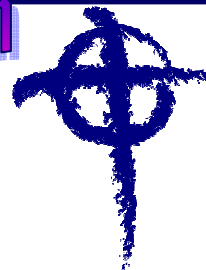

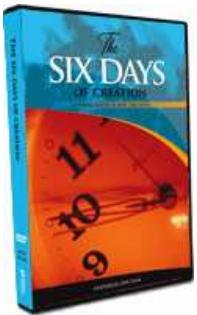

## An Apostolic-Prophetic people worshipping Jesus

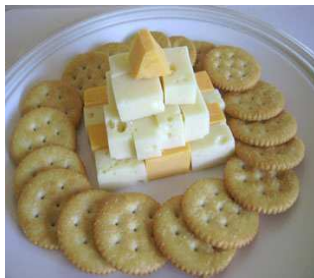

This summer we are planning a Baptism.

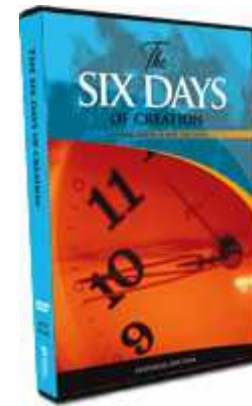
Classes start soon. Please call Louise at 545-3092 so we can set up a suitable time.
