Marriage Tip with Mark Gungor

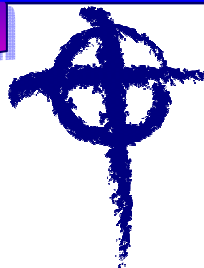

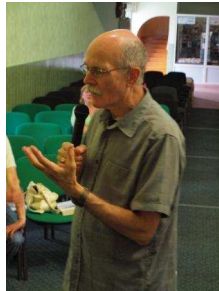

* **Aarron**, Louise's Niece, who is suffering from severe epilepsy

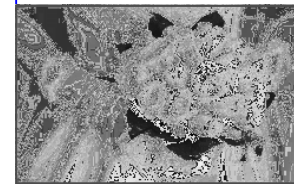
* **Neil**, Louise's cousin, who had his foot run over and has had 3 surgeries on his shattered ankle.
