

Recent Changes At The Sanctuary

Ralph has been receiving a monthly donation directly into a retirement fund (RRSP) on a monthly basis for many years instead of a pension. When he went "off salary" he agreed with the leadership that he would continue to minister on Sundays in the pulpit 3 times a month and accept this donation to his RRSPs as "salary" for his work (slightly short of minimum wage per hour). Due to changes in the financial situation here at The Sanctuary it is no longer possible to continue this monthly donation. As a result of this change Ralph is now free to travel and minister elsewhere on Sundays as we cannot expect him to minister for nothing. He has graciously agreed to continue to teach from our Sunday pulpit for March and April as the schedules for these two months had already been determined. This will allow our growing "teach team" an opportunity to plan and adjust to these major changes. We appreciate his willingness to do this for our local church.

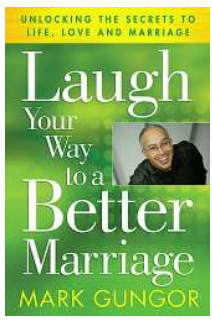
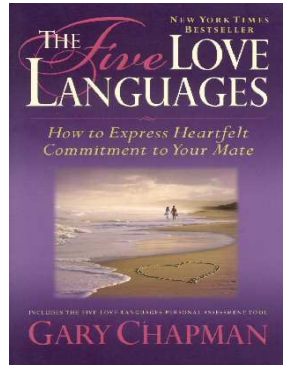

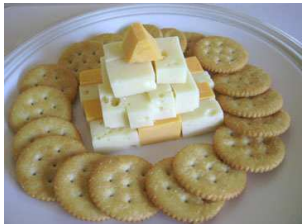
