Pastors and leaders from 5 cities gathered for two days to learn and grow. Topic: Supernatural Evangelism and Church Planting

The Bible states that "those who know their God do mighty exploits" (Daniel 11:32) and we know God because we are born again and have the gift of eternal life (Romans 6:23 and John 17:3). So, we are to be doing mighty exploits for God. I recently met a group of disciples who are doing just that and it was an

exciting time of listening to their heart for Jesus and their dedication and willingness to sacrifice even life itself if more people would come to know Jesus! I was there to lead and teach them and yet they encouraged me and taught me so much.

One church was 16 years old and had planted 11 other churches in three nations with plans to begin in a fourth and continue more plants where they are already working. They were not wealthy by any means as they are located in one of the poorest nations of the former Soviet Union...but they were dedicated and focused and willing to do whatever it takes. They live for Jesus! They talk about Jesus! They want the lost to know Jesus! It was refreshing and life-giving to be with them and share fellowship together.

I believe we have so much here in North America. We are wealthy and seriously blessed when compared to other world nations and people. And, I believe that God is calling us to make a serious difference in the lives of those around us and in many nations of the world. We tend to look at what we don't have and can't do. We need to look at what we do have and can do. We can share Jesus here at home and in other nations - we have all that it takes to do just that. We simply need to want to! And, when we do, it will literally transform our lives.

People without a personal relationship with Jesus do not go to Heaven when they die. And, they will never come to personally know Jesus if we are not about "our Father's business" and seriously and sacrificially focused on seeing them come to foot of the cross. Join me in a renewed dedication to take the world for Jesus one person at a time and nation by nation.
